# Charts and Signs: Visual Presentation

## Purpose

To ground the participants in the Scriptural realities of the events in the room.

## Way of Being

Alert, exact, diligent.

## General Description

As the team member responsible for charts, signs, and visual material, it will be your job to oversee the production and placement of all visual material before and during the sessions. This job requires being prepared, being alert to details, and having some basic visual design. Like every other member of the team, you exemplify the training itself by being its principles.

## Mechanics

### Before the Training

- ➔ Ask if any of the signs are already made and available for use. Coordinate with the sponsor on the inventory of signs needed. All signs can be found on the [Breakthrough Resources page](https://theflourishinglife.org.com/bt-training-resources/) of the website. (<https://theflourishinglife.org.com/bt-training-resources/>)
- ➔ If signs exist, inspect them out for flaws or other damage well in advance of the training.
- ➔ Become familiar with what needs to be on the wall for each day during training.
- ➔ Have an "Emergency Number" sign posted for family of participants to use to reach participants in case of an emergency.
- ➔ With the sponsor, team captain, and room set-up team member, determine how and where to arrange the signs in a visually balanced manner and **without damaging any of the walls** or other surfaces.
- ➔ Coordinate with supply team member to make sure you have all the materials you need to create new or unanticipated signs during the training itself.
- ➔ Be aware of the large investment in all materials and treat them with utmost care. Handle all materials in a way that they will be preserved.

### During the Training

- ➔ On the day of the training, request help in putting up signs and rearranging them if asked, making new posters, and keeping the room balanced visually.

- ➔ **DO NOT USE DUCT TAPE** to put up signs! When using plastic to cover windows, do not apply adhesive or tape directly to a painted surface.
- ➔ Know which scriptures/posters are “thematic” for the day (see list of signs for each day).
- ➔ Place theme scriptures prominently on front wall.
- ➔ At the end of each day, make required sign changes.
- ➔ Store all signs safely when not in use.

## After the Training

- ➔ Return all material to its appropriate place.
- ➔ Make sure all material is packaged and stored safely so as to preserve quality.

## Charts/Signs Summary

Put up the signs shown for each day as listed below. Take note of those signs that should be taken down.

### Thursday Signs:

Place the theme signs (outlined in **black**) at the front of the room during room set-up on Wednesday evening. Signs outlined in **blue** may be hung at the sides or the back of the training room.

#### PROMISE

*In a general sense it is a declaration written or verbal made by one person to another, which binds the person who makes it either in honor, conscience, or law to do or forbear a certain act. A declaration that gives the person to whom it was made a right to expect or claim the performance or forbearance of the act.*
